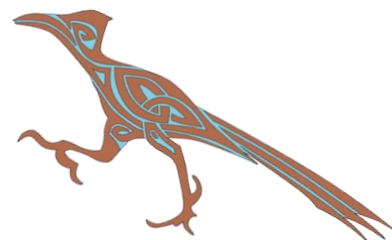

NOTE: No fee to advance level(s) for Arizona Roadrunner Feis if changed by 6:00pm on Saturday, May 4th, 2024. Otherwise, day of feis changes to advance level(s) will be subject to a \$10 change fee. If the level advancement is from non-champion to preliminary champion the \$15 difference in entry fees will be due regardless of registration change date/time.

NOTE: If you are a Preliminary Championship dancer and receive your 3rd first place win at the Feile Rince Tucson, you must move to Open Championship level to compete on Sunday at the Arizona Roadrunner Feis.

DEADLINE:

Late entry fee of \$25 after 4/19/2024. **Cap of 175 dancers**

Registration is only guaranteed with payment prior to reaching cap.

Registration closes 4/29/2024. Same day registrations if cap hasn't been met (Add'l \$25).

Arizona Roadrunner Feis Rules

1. The Arizona Roadrunner Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the Irish Dance Teachers Association of North America and Western US Regional Council.
2. Competitors must be prepared to dance 30 minutes prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
Dancers that appear in competitions in which they are not paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
3. When awards are announced, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.

4. No videotaping or flash photography of dance competitions is permitted.
5. The Feile Rince Tucson, Arizona Roadrunner Feis, The Maguire Academy of Irish Dance, The Sheraton, the feis committee, and anyone associated with the committee in putting on the feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the feis, by any participant or anyone attending the feis. By entering the feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's legal guardian and guests agree to indemnify and hold harmless the feis, feis committee, vendors, volunteers and venue and it's personnel for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation in the feis.
6. Any competitors choosing to wear black out must wear *appropriate* black shirts and black skirts with black tights or white poodle socks for girls and black pants for boys. To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or capped sleeve tops and no specific school identification by words, letters, or symbols. Please refer to the CLRG website for full costuming rules.
7. An Advanced Adult is defined as anyone 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Preliminary Championship or competed at the Open Championship level in the youth/and over levels, regardless of when the competitor was last active.

Advanced Adults do not need to be out of competition for 5 years before moving from the youth/and over categories to Advanced Adults.

Dancers who have already been competing in the regular Adult categories do not need to move to Advanced Adults, regardless of their level or placements achieved when competing in youth/and over.

An Advanced Adult dancer who has opted to leave youth/and over categories may not return to youth/and over categories once the dancer begins competing in Advanced Adult
8. Adults MAY NOT enter both solos and championship at the same feis. However, in the case of back-to-back feiseanna, adults may compete in championship in one and solos in the other
