<p>Competition Rules</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Scottsdale Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the Western US Regional Council and the Irish Dance Teachers' Association of North America. 2. Dancer's age is determined as of January 1st. 3. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event. 4. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards. 5. First feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis. 6. Adults MAY NOT enter both solos and championship at the same feis. However, in the case of back-to-back feiseanna, adults may compete solos for one feis and championship for the other. 7. Adults: Dancers who started after the age of 18, or who have been out of competitions for 5 years. Advanced Adults: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. An Advanced Adult dancer is defined as anyone age 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Prelim Championship or competed in Open Champ levels in the youth/& over levels regardless of when the competitor was active. b. An Advanced Adult dancer has opted to leave Youth/&over categories and once the dancer begins competing in Advanced Adult, the dancer may not return to Youth/& Over categories. c. Advanced Adult Championships at NAIDC 2024 and WUSR 2024 will dance Reel/hornpipe. In 2025, Advanced Adults shall follow the rotation of dances for the Senior Ladies/Men age groups. For the recall round, set of choice will be performed. 8. The feis committee reserves the right to combine or split competitions following the guidelines of the IDTANA and the Western US Regional Council. All efforts will be made to combine competitions where there are fewer than 5 competitors entered. 9. The Michael Patrick Gallagher School of Irish Dance, The Phoenix Irish Heritage Association, The Grand Canyon State Feis, The Scottsdale Feis, and The DoubleTree Resort will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, illness, property loss, and/or damage. By entering this feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the above-mentioned parties from any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.
