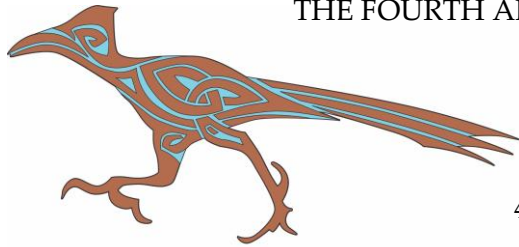

### ENTRY FEES

Soft Shoe - \$20

Hard Shoe - \$15

Championships – (3 rounds) \$50

Figures - \$10 flat fee per dancer

Art Competition - \$5

Specials - \$10

Family admission fee of \$25 per family is added at time of registration; includes online results

Family Maximum - \$150 (excluding specials or cultural competition)

**NOTE:** No fee to advance level(s) from Féile Rince Tucson if changed by 6:00pm on Saturday, May 4, 2019. Otherwise, day of feis changes to advance level(s) will be subject to a \$10 change fee. If the level advancement is from non-champion to preliminary champion the \$15 difference in entry fees will be due regardless of registration change date/time.

**NOTE:** If you are a Preliminary Championship level dancer and you win your 3rd first place at Féile Rince Tucson on Saturday, you must move to Open Championship level to compete at the Arizona Roadrunner Feis on Sunday.

**ARIZONA ROADRUNNER FEIS RULES**

	1	Arizona Roadrunner Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the North American Feis Commission (NAFC) ( <a href="http://www.northamericanfeiscommission.org">www.northamericanfeiscommission.org</a> ). All rules of the NAFC are included by reference.
	2	Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
	3	Dancers that appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
	4	When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
	5	No videotaping or flash photography of dance competitions is permitted.
	6	Arizona Roadrunner Feis, The Celtic Academy of Tucson, The Maguire Academy of Irish Dance, The DoubleTree by Hilton, the Feis Committee, and anyone associated with the committee in putting on the Feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the Feis, by any participants, or by anyone attending the event. By entering the feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's legal guardian and guests agree to indemnify and hold harmless the feis, the feis committee, volunteers, vendors, and venue and its personnel for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation in the feis.
	7	Blackout guidelines: All competitions may be danced in <i>appropriate</i> black shirts and black skirts with black tights or black poodle socks for girls and black pants for boys. To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or capped sleeve tops and no specific school identification by words, letters, or symbols. Please refer to the North American Feis Commission website for full costuming rules. Blackout attire is optional.
