NOTE: No fee to advance level(s) for Arizona Roadrunner Feis if changed by 6:00pm on Saturday, May 2, 2020. Otherwise, day of feis changes to advance level(s) will be subject to a \$10 change fee. If the level advancement is from non-champion to preliminary champion the \$15 difference in entry fees will be due regardless of registration change date/time.

NOTE: If you are a Preliminary Championship dancer and receive your 3rd first place win at Feile Rince Tucson, you must move to Open Championship level to compete on Sunday at the Arizona Roadrunner Feis.

<b>ARIZONA ROADRUNNER FEIS RULES</b>																	
	1	Arizona Roadrunner Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the North American Feis Commission (NAFC) ( <a href="http://www.northamericanfeiscommission.org">www.northamericanfeiscommission.org</a> ). All rules of the NAFC are included by reference.															
	2	Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.															
	3	Dancers that appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.															
	4	When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.															
	5	No videotaping or flash photography of dance competitions is permitted.															
	6	The Feile Rince Tucson, Arizona Roadrunner Feis, The Maguire Academy of Irish Dance, The Hilton Tucson East, the Feis Committee, and anyone associated with the committee in putting on the Feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the Feis, by any participants, or by anyone attending the event. By entering the feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's legal guardian and guests agree to indemnify and hold harmless the feis, the feis committee, volunteers, vendors, and venue and its personnel for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation in the feis.															
	7	Blackout guidelines: All competitions may be danced in <i>appropriate</i> black shirts and black skirts with black tights or white poodle socks for girls and black pants for boys. To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or capped sleeve tops and no specific school identification by words, letters, or symbols. When wearing body suits with skirts black tights (of a denier no less than 70) must be worn from the age of 14 and above. Please refer to the North American Feis Commission website for full costuming rules. Black out attire is optional.															
	8	Please note: The feis committee reserves the right to combine or split competitions following the guidelines of the NAFC and the Western US Region Teacher's Association.
