Solo Requirements (Beginner 1 through Prizewinner):

16 bars (1 step) Right and Left foot, except Traditional Set (Full Dance)

Please note: Dancers will perform one at a time in all competitions except Traditional Set for non-champ dancers (stage will be split and dancers will perform two at a time)

LEVEL ADVANCEMENT AND DEFINITION

As specified in the Western US Region Standard Syllabus

- **First Feis** is not per dance, it is the first Feis ever for the dancer. A dancer has only one 'first feis' regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may enter First Feis only once, even in cases of back-to-back feiseanna.
- In **Beginner 1, Beginner 2 and Novice** the following will apply:
 - 5 - 9 dancers 1st place will advance to the next grade
 - 10 or more dancers 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade
- Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion, with the exception of back-to-back feiseanna.
- **Prizewinner:** Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.
- **Preliminary to Open Championship:** Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round Preliminary Championships.
- **Adults:** Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have been out of conventional competitions for 5 years.
- **Beginner Figures:** Open only to dancers entered in beginner for at least one solo dance.
- **Open Figures:** Open to all grades levels.

DANCING COMPETITION RULES

1. Rules 1-34 adopted by North American Feis Commission, effective 1/1/2020, are included by reference.
2. Competitor's age will be determined as of January 1, 2020.
3. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event. Competitors who fail to report on time to compete will be disqualified from said event pursuant to Rule 3(b) of the NAFC Dancing Competitions Rules.
4. Dancers who appear in competitions for which they are not registered will not be eligible for placement or awards.
5. When awards are announced, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
6. The McTeggart Irish Stepdancers of Colorado, the Feis Committee and anyone associated with the Committee in presenting the Feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the feis, by any participants, or by anyone attending the event. By entering this feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless this feis, the feis committee, volunteers, vendors, and venue for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation in this feis.

INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL MUSIC - Competition 950

Entries will be divided based on instrument and age. Soloists only.

Requirements:

- Only traditional Irish or Scottish music will be accepted.
- Electronic or amplified instruments will not be permitted, with the exception of keyboards.
- Instrumental: Play two tunes of contrasting tempos. 2 minutes maximum per tune.
- Vocal: Perform one song. 3 minutes maximum.
