

Safety Procedures and Protocol



Only the judges, musician, stage managers, dancers, and one registered spectator for each dancer will be permitted into the competition. Pairs of chairs for the dancer and spectator will be placed 10-12 feet apart. Entrance and exit from the competition will be facilitated by the stage managers. Masks must be worn by everyone at all times. It is important that everyone follow the rules so that we run a safe Feis, and all of our attendees feel comfortable. Anyone not following the rules risks immediate disqualification from the Feis and will be asked to leave the competition area. More details will be provided for registering as a spectator once you have paid your registrations on Feisworx. One registered spectator per dancer will be permitted. You must register prior to arriving at the Feis. This is important for contact tracing, and no exceptions will be made.

Required:

Masks
Paper or plastic bag for placing mask while dancing
Number card (dancers must print and bring)

Recommended:

Hand sanitizer
Wipes
Personal seat cover
Your own water bottle with water

Competitions:

- ❖ No competition will run early. Follow the CIDAC Championships on Twitter for updates regarding late competitions and award times.
- ❖ Dancers should arrive 10 minutes prior to their competition start time and be DANCE READY. Please do not arrive any earlier, as there is no “camping” or practicing available in the outside common area.
- ❖ Dancers and the (one) REGISTERED spectator can check in and pick up their wristband 15 minutes prior to their competition. If you are in more than one competition, you will get all your wristbands when you check in for the first comp.
- ❖ If you do not have a bag for your mask, a paper bag will be available when you pick up your wristbands.

- ❖ Temperatures will be taken for the dancers and spectators prior to entering the competition area.
- ❖ Everyone for the scheduled competition will line up with a minimum of 6 ft. social distancing spacing until the stage manager lets the competition in after dismissing the prior group.
- ❖ Once you have entered the competition area, dancers and spectators must remain in their seats unless lined up or dancing. You may not wander the ballroom, congregate in groups, or socialize with other dancers/spectators. Choose your pair of seats and remain until the competition has ended and the stage manager dismisses everyone.
- ❖ When dancers are called to line up, they will stand on the markers along the side of the stage. They may take their mask off, place it in their bag, and on the table before lining up. After they have danced, they must exit the stage and pick up their bag and put their mask back on and return to their seat.

Awards:

- ❖ Only Championship Competitions will be announced.
- ❖ Award times will be posted on Twitter throughout the day.
- ❖ Awards will be held outdoors, with a socially distanced podium set up.
- ❖ The dancer numbers of the dancers expected at awards will also be posted. Those dancers (and their REGISTERED spectator) are the ONLY ones who should be present at awards. Please respect this.
- ❖ Trophies and sashes will be pre-placed on the podiums and wiped prior to announcing the competition.
- ❖ With exception of the Reel Specials, all Beginner through Prizewinner competition results will be available on-line ONLY. There will NOT be a results room with posted results.
- ❖ The Non-Championship dancers may pick up their medals at a designated location. The “Rising Star” awards will be awarded on stage immediately following those competitions.
