**Traditional Irish Baking:** We will be offering several categories this year for traditional Irish baking. What a great opportunity to share your culinary skills! All entries must be received by Noon on Saturday, January 27, 2018.

Entry Categories include:

Traditional Savory Breads (soda, brown, yeast)

Traditional Sweet Breads (soda with raisins, scones)

Other traditional sweets (non bread, cake, specialties)

Must include a list of ingredients and any condiments.

Entries will be judged on authenticity, visual appeal, taste /texture.

Awards should be posted around 2:00PM (subject to change)

2. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
3. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
4. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
5. When awards are announced, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
