CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITIONS

All Championship Dancers will compete two at a time.

Preliminary Championships will consist of 2 rounds:

48 bars Reel/40 bars Slip Jig, and 40 bars Hornpipe/48 bars Treble Jig.

Open Championships will consist of 3 rounds:

48 bars Reel/40 bars Slip Jig, and 40 bars Hornpipe/48 bars Treble Jig, and set dance.

All U9 Open Champion Dancers MUST dance Traditional Set.

Adult Championships will consist of 3 rounds:

48 bars Reel/40 bars Slip Jig, and 40 bars Hornpipe/48 bars Treble Jig, and traditional set.

Advanced Adult Championships will consist of 3 rounds:

48 bars Reel/40 bars Slip Jig, and 40 bars Hornpipe/48 bars Treble Jig, and set dance.

Any competition with fewer than 5 competitors may be combined with next higher age group.

Dancing Competition Rules

- 1. Cowboy State Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the Western US Regional Council and the Irish Dance Teachers' Association of North America.
- 2. Dancer's age is determined as of January 1st.
- **3.** First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis. Dancer may only enter First Feis once even in the case of back-to-back Feisianna.
- **4.** Competitions of four or fewer competitors may be combined; sixteen or more competitors may be split by age if there are a minimum of five dancers in each age group.
- 5. Competitors must be at the stage, prepared to dance, at least fifteen minutes prior to the beginning of their scheduled event
- **6.** Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
- 7. When awards are announced, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards. Only Championship and Specials will be announced and given in person. Results for Grades will be posted and available on Feisworx. There will be a designated area to pick up awards for Grades. Awards will not be mailed.
- **8.** Championship competitions are awarded by the entire adjudicator panel; individual rounds will be awarded based on one, randomly selected, adjudicator's scores as in solo competitions.
- **9.** Blackout Guidelines: Competitions will be danced in appropriate black shirts and black skirts with black spankies/tights for girls or black shorts/pants for boys. To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or cap sleeve tops and no specific school identification by lettering, words or symbol.
- **10.** Music Competition Guidelines: Beginner (played for one year or less) plays two tunes of contrasting tempo. Advanced plays three tunes of contrasting tempo from the selection of tunes. The Selection of Tunes are Jigs (Single Jig / Double Jigs / Slip Jigs), Reels, Polkas, Marches, Hornpipes and Airs. No amplified instruments allowed.
- 11. Definition of Adults & Advanced Adults:
 - a. Adults: Dancers who started after the age of 18, or who have been out of competitions for 5 years.
 - b. Advanced Adults: Anyone age 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Prelim Championship or competed in Open Champ levels in the youth/& over levels regardless of when the competitor was active. An Advanced Adult dancer has opted to leave youth/& over categories and once the dancer begins competing in Advanced Adult, the dancer may not return to youth/& over categories. Advanced Adult Championships at NAIDC 2024 and WUSR 2024 will dance Reel/Hornpipe. In 2025, Advanced Adults shall follow the rotation of dances for the Senior Ladies/Men age groups. For the recall round, set of choice will be performed
- 12. Beginner Figures are open only to dancers in beginner for at least one solo dance.
- **13.** Open Figures are open to all grade levels.
- 14. The Michael Patrick Gallagher School of Irish Dance, the Irish Dance Association of Central Wyoming, the Feis Committee and anyone associated with the Committee in putting on the Feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss or damage incurred before, during, or after the Feis, by any participants or by anyone attending the event. By entering the feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the above-mentioned parties from any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.
