	3	Dancers that appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.											
	4	First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.											
	5	When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.											
	6	No videotaping or flash photography of dance competitions is permitted.
