Payments for the Feis will open no earlier than November 20, 2020.

Those dancers registered below the cap will be given first priority to pay. If after one or two days payments are not received, then payments will be accepted from waitlisted dancers.

**Registration Entries & Payments must be postmarked by Friday, November 27, 2020.
Payment must be received for entries to be validated.**

Late fee of \$25 per entry for entries/payments postmarked after November 27, 2020.

Rules:

1. All rules of the North American Feis Commission (www.northamericanfeiscommission.org) are included by reference.
2. Competitor's age will be determined as of January 1, 2020.
3. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement and awards.
4. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
5. Competitors must be at the stage, prepared to dance, no more than fifteen minutes prior to the beginning of their scheduled event. To encourage social distancing and prevent overcrowding, no dance will begin before the scheduled time.
6. The Wick School of Irish Dance, Colorado Celtic Dance Association ("CCDA") and Hilton Denver Inverness will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage incurred before, during or after the Feis. By entering this Feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the CCDA, Front Range Feis, The Feis Committee, Feis Volunteers, Vendors, Hilton Denver Inverness and the Wick School of Irish Dance for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.

Note:

- * Every effort will be made to split or combine competitors where it will most benefit all dancers.
- * Times and competition stage locations are subject to change, even during the competition day.

Covid 19 Modifications:

A full list of Covid rules and requirements will be provided on Feisworx. Please expect that masks will be required and dancers will be limited to one spectator per dancer. Dancers will not be required to wear a mask while dancing.

Level Advancement and Definition:

First Feis is not per dance, it is the first Feis ever for the dancer, regardless of how many dances the dancer is doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in the case of back-to-back Feisanna.

Beginner 1, Beginner 2 and Novice

- * 5-9 Dancers - 1st Place advances to the next grade level
- * 10 or more dancers - 1st and 2nd places advance to the next grade level
- * *Dancers may not stay in a grade at teacher discretion, with the exception of back-to-back feisanna*

Prizewinner - Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

Preliminary to Open Championship

- * Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers. Not at teacher discretion.
- * Upon the 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championship, a dancer must immediately move to Open, even in the case of back-to-back feisanna. This includes 2 and 3-round Preliminary Championships.

Adults - Dancers who started dancing after the age of 18 or who have been out of competition for 5 years.

Competition and Awards Details:

- * All results will be posted online on Feisworx. There will NOT be a results room with posted results.
- * Only Championship Competitions will be announced.
- * First Feis - Prizewinner Dancers may pick up their medals at a designated location (TBD).

Sunday Schedule

Graded Solo Competitions: All dancers will perform one at a time for 16 bars, one step right and left foot, except for St. Patrick's Day and Traditional Set (the dancers will perform the full dance two at a time on a split stage).

Preliminary Championship - Open to dancers who have NOT won 3 firsts in their overall Preliminary Championships with 5 or more dancers. Immediately following a 3rd first place, dancers must move to Open Championships, even in the case of back-to-back feisanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round championships.
