## Rules:

1. All rules of the North American Feis Commission ([www.northamericanfeiscommission.org](http://www.northamericanfeiscommission.org)) are included by reference.
2. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
3. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
4. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
5. When awards are announced, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
6. The Wick School of Irish Dance, Colorado Celtic Dance Association and Hamilton Middle School will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage. By entering this Feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the CCDA, Colorado WinterFeis, The Feis Committee, Feis Volunteers, Vendors, Hamilton Middle School and the Wick School of Irish Dance for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.

# Syllabus

## Level Advancement and Definition

**First Feis** – Dancers may only enter First Feis once, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna. First Feis is defined as the first Feis a dancer participates in, regardless of how many dances the dancer registers for.

## Beginner 1, Beginner 2, and Novice

- 5-9 Dancers – 1<sup>st</sup> place advances to the next grade
- 10 or more dancers – 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places advance to the next grade
- ***Dancers may not stay in a grade at teacher discretion.***

**Prizewinner** – Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championships is at teacher discretion.

## Preliminary to Open Championship

- Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion.
- Upon their 3<sup>rd</sup> overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must immediately move to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna.

**Adults** – Dancers who started after the age of 18 or who have been out of competition for 5 years.

**Beginner Figures** – Open only to dancers in beginner for at least one solo dance.

**Open Figures** – Open to all grade levels
