Family Maximum - \$150 (excluding specials and cultural competitions)

NOTE: No fee to advance level(s) for Arizona Black Out Feis if changed by 6:00pm on Saturday, September 28, 2019. Otherwise, day of feis changes to advance level(s) will be subject to a \$10 change fee. If the level advancement is from non-champion to preliminary champion the \$15 difference in entry fees will be due regardless of registration change date/time.

NOTE: If you are a Preliminary Championship dancer and receive your 3rd first place win at the Maguire Halloween Feis, you must move to Open Championship level to compete on Sunday at the Arizona Black Out Feis.

<b>THE MAGUIRE HALLOWEEN FEIS RULES</b>													
	1	The Maguire Halloween Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the North American Feis Commission (NAFC)											
	2	Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.											
	3	Dancers that appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.											
	4	When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.											
	5	No videotaping or flash photography of dance competitions is permitted.											
	6	The Maguire Halloween Feis, Arizona Black Out Feis, The Maguire Academy of Irish Dance, The DoubleTree by Hilton, the Feis Committee, and anyone associated											
	7	Blackout guidelines: All competitions may be danced in <i>appropriate</i> black shirts and black skirts with black tights or white poodle socks for girls and black pants for boys. To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or capped sleeve tops and no specific school identification by words, letters, or symbols.
