## **Requirement for Specials**

Warmup Specials—these specials will happen at the very beginning of both the morning and afternoon sessions to give dancers a chance to get warmed up and try out the stage before the regular solo competitions start. Each dancer will do 1 step of the soft shoe reel down the line. Grades and Champs will have separate competitions.

Treble Reel—each dancer will do 1 step of the hard shoe reel down the line. Grades and Champs will have separate competitions.

Irish Story—write your own Irish-themed short-short story (word limit: 250). Stories should have a title and be printed on one 8.5” x 11” piece of paper (one side only). Please write your competitor number on the front (not your name). You can bring the printed story with you to the feis and turn it in at the registration table by 9 a.m., or you can copy and paste it into the body of an email and send it to [HeritageIrish@aol.com](mailto:HeritageIrish@aol.com) by Thursday, July 11.
