## **DANCING COMPETITION RULES**

1. All rules of the North American Feis Commission ([www.northamericanfeiscommission.org](http://www.northamericanfeiscommission.org)) are included by reference.
2. Competitions may be combined if warranted by the number of entries.
3. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
4. Dancers who dance in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
5. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
6. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
7. The Yeates Academy of Irish Dance, The Sheraton Portland Airport Hotel, The Feis Committee and anyone associated with the Committee in running and organizing the Feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the feis, by any participants, or by anyone attending the event.

### **ENTRY PROCEDURES AND FEES**

Entries are handled by FeisWorx [www.feisworx.com](http://www.feisworx.com). Payments should be made online . Payments by mail must be payable in US Dollars to Yeates Academy of Irish Dance, and mailed to Yeates Academy of Irish Dance, c/o FeisWorx, P.O. Box 2046, Parker, CO 80134. Online payment is strongly recommended to avoid problems with mail delivery. Mail from Canada is slow, two weeks lead time is recommended.

**Entries and payments are due Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018.** Payments postmarked after that date must include a \$30 late fee. **Note: Entry fees are non-refundable.**

No advance registration or entry fee.

- ❖ Entry of one poem, in any form, with an Irish theme or topic.
- ❖ Limited to 20 lines or fewer.
- ❖ Please submit on one page (8 ½ x 11 paper only) the previously unpublished poem and its title. The poem page should **not** include the dancer's name and **no frames or matting please.**
- ❖ Add another page as a cover sheet which includes the title of the poem, the poet's name, age, telephone number, and dance school affiliation (siblings of dancers are welcome to enter).
- ❖ Enter the poetry competition via FeisWorx and bring the poem to the registration table by **10:00 am on Saturday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. Alternately, the poem may be mailed to the feis on or before Thursday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
