Thank you for attending the 7th annual St. Paul Autumn Feis. We're grateful that we've been given this opportunity to put this event on. For this weekend to run smoothly and safely for everyone, it will be very important that everyone understands and follows the rules and restrictions. If you feel that you or your dancer will not be able to comply with the following restrictions, we gracefully request that you not register for our event at this time, and we hope to see you in the Spring.

-If you or your dancer are experiencing any COVID symptoms please stay home.

-Each registered dancer will be allowed **ONE GUEST ONLY**, no exceptions.

-MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES by both spectators and dancers; dancers may remove their mask when on stage only.

-Please refer to the Stage Assignments on Feisworx for your stage start time. Please do not arrive more than 30 minutes prior to your start time as you will not be allowed in.

-Once you are done dancing and awards have been posted, we kindly ask that you leave the facility through the designated exit doors. This will allow us adequate cleaning time between groups.

-PC awards will be by recall only.

-OC dancers are invited to pick up their awards at the awards table; we will not be announcing results at the podiums.

-We will not be offering concessions.

-We hope to be able to offer a used dress rack. Please check back closer to the event for a final decision.

-We will not be offering hotel room blocks this year. Please see our website www.idpamn.org for a list of recommended hotels in the area.

-Both Saturday and Sunday are "black out" days. Competitions will be danced in appropriate black t-shirts and black skirts/shorts with black spankies/tights for girls or black shorts/pants for boys. To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or cap sleeve tops and no specific school identification by lettering, words or symbol.
