## FEIS RULES

1. All rules of the North American Feis Commission [www.northamericanfeiscommission.org](http://www.northamericanfeiscommission.org) are included by reference.
2. Flash photography and the use of video recording devices are strictly prohibited. *The Feis may elect to have a professional photographer present for publicity purposes only.*
3. First Feis entrants may not compete in the same dance in a higher category.
4. Any competition with less than 5 competitors may be combined with next higher age group.
5. Competitors must be at the stage, prepared to dance, at least fifteen minutes prior to the beginning of their scheduled event.
6. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
7. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
8. Championship competitions are awarded by the entire adjudicator panel; individual rounds will be awarded based on one, randomly selected, adjudicator's scores as in solo competitions.

Awards will be announced throughout the competition day. A tentative schedule will be provided with your registration materials and posted throughout the venue.
