Open – 3 rounds 48 bars of Reel or 40 bars of Slip Jig & 48 bars of Treble Jig or 40 bars of Hornpipe & Set of Choice

Please Note: For U9 and younger Open Champ age categories, set dance is traditional set dance only. If combines with U10 or older due to low entry numbers, they may dance a non-traditional set.

U15 and younger dancers will dance 3 at a time in hard shoe round. All other age groups and all soft shoe rounds will dance 2 at a time.

#### **COSTUME GUIDELINES:**

THIS IS CASUAL DRESS FEIS! WE ECOURAGE NO DANCING COSTUMES, SOLO OR TEAM DRESSES/VESTS OR WAISTCOATS, WIGS ETC.

All Dancers are encouraged to wear casual dress with Halloween flare! Shorts, skirts, pants, leggings, dresses are all acceptable. Wear your Halloween costume! There will be prizes for best dressed dancers so go "all out!" (Be sure the judge can properly assess your dancing. All CLRG costume rules must be followed)

\*\*To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or capped sleeve tops and no specific school identification by words, letters, or symbols. Please refer to the CLRG website for full costuming rules. Adjudicators may ask dancer to put on tights if skirt deemed inappropriate.

#### **DANCING COMPETITION RULES:**

- O Rules and requirements for each competition noted in the syllabus are included by reference.
- Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled start of their event.
- O Competitions with fewer than five entrants may be combined or cancelled by the Feis Committee.
- o The Feis Committee may add or combine specials at its discretion.
- O Syllabus subject to be revised as numbers of competitors require.
- O Competitors must be in costume, including soft shoes, to receive awards presented from stage.
- O Avoca Academy of Irish Dance, Moriarty-Moffitt Dancers Foundation and Delta Marriott Hotel will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage incurred before, during or after the

Feis.
