NOTE: No fee to advance level(s) for Arizona Black Out Feis if changed by 6:00pm on Saturday, October 12th, 2024. Otherwise, day of feis changes to advance level(s) will be subject to a \$10 change fee. If level advancement is from non-champion to preliminary champion the \$15 difference in entry fees will be due regardless of registration change date/time.

NOTE: If you are a Preliminary Championship dancer and receive your 3rd first place win at the Maguire Halloween Feis, you must move to Open Championship level to compete on Sunday at the Arizona Black Out Feis.

Requirement: Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (40 bars), and Treble Jig (48 bar) or Hornpipe (40 bars), choice of set. See Feis Rules below for definition of advanced adult.

### **Arizona Black Out Feis Rules**

- 1. The Arizona Black Out Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the Irish Dance Teachers' Association of North America and the Western US Regional Council.
- 2. Competitors must be prepared to dance 30 minutes prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.

  Dancers that appear in competitions in which they are not paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
- 3. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, to receive their awards.
- 4. No videotaping or flash photography of dance competitions is permitted.

- 5. The Maguire Halloween Feis, Arizona Black Out Feis, The Maguire Academy of Irish Dance, The Sheraton, the feis committee, and anyone associated with the committee in putting on the feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the feis, by any participant or anyone attending the feis. By entering the feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's legal guardian and guests agree to idemnify and hold harmless the feis, feis committee, vendors, volunteers and venue and it's personnel for any liabilities ore personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation in the feis.
- 6. BlackOut guidelines: All competitions may be danced in *appropriate* black shirts and black skirts with black tights or white poodle socks for girls and black pants for boys. To meet CLRG considerations, "appropriate" is defined as not too short (mid-thigh length is appropriate), not too tight, no scooped necklines, no sleeveless or capped sleeve tops and no specific school identification by words, letters, or symbols. Please refer to CLRG website for full costuming rules. Adjudicators may ask dancer to wear tights if skirt deemed inappropriate. Black Out attire is not required.
- 7. No outside food or drink public spaces. Per Arizona Liquor Law, no outside alcohol allowed in public areas.
- 8. An Advanced Adult it defined as anyone 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Preliminary
