### **From the Feis Committee:**

1. The Feis Committee has the option of splitting or combining competitions as necessary.
2. At the discretion of the Feis Committee, stage assignments may change; announcements will be made at the original stage and/or over the public address system. It is the competitor's responsibility to report promptly to the correct stage.
3. Competitors must be at their assigned stage ready to compete when their competitions are ready or announced. A competitor may be eliminated from a competition for reporting late. Competitions will be closed when no more competitors are at the stage ready to compete. No competition shall be re-opened except on the sole direction of the Feis Coordinators.

4. Parents not accompanying competitors under age 18 are strongly encouraged to provide their child(ren)'s chaperones with signed medical authorizations. Parents/Chaperones are solely responsible for their children's/charges' safety.

5. All medals/trophies must be picked up on the day of the Feis. Only awards omitted in error will be mailed by the Feis Committee. You must have your number to collect your results.

### **Dancing Competition Rules:**

1. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event. The Feis is at liberty to run up to one hour ahead of schedule. Every effort will be made to ensure proper notification and announcements of competitions should the schedule be ahead or behind.

2. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.

3. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a Feis, and not on a per dance basis. Once you have competed in First Feis, no future dances may be danced under this category.

4. When awards are announced, competitors must be in full costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.

5. Neither Celtic Irish Dance Academy nor the Sonesta Los Angeles Airport shall be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage. By entering this Feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the CIDA Stars Summer Feis 2026, The Feis Committee, Feis Volunteers, Vendors, the Sonesta Los Angeles Airport, or Celtic Irish Dance Academy for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.
