Entry fees must be received by the closing date to avoid late fees.

#### **LEVEL ADVANCEMENT & DEFINITION**

**First Feis** is not per dance. It is the first Feis ever for the dancer. Dancers may only enter First Feis once, even in case of back-to-back Feiseanna.

#### In B1, B2, and Novice the following will apply:

5 - 9 Dancers1st place will advance to the next grade level10+ Dancers1st and 2nd place will advance to the next grade level

\*Please note: Dancers may not stay in a level at Teacher discretion. Dancers must advance based on the placement awarded.

#### **Prizewinner:**

Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher's discretion.

#### Preliminary to Open Championship:

Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning their 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feisanna.

#### Adults:

Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have not competed for 5 years.

#### Advanced Adults:

An Advanced Adult dancer is defined as anyone age 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Prelim Championship or competed in Open Champ levels in the youth & over levels regardless of when the competitor was active. An Advanced Adult dancer has opted to leave Youth & Over categories and once the dancer begins competing in Advanced Adult, the dancer may not return to Youth & Over categories.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIPS**

All championships will be adjudicated by a panel of three. Each round of the Championship (Reel/Slip Jig, Jig/Hornpipe, Set Dance) will be judged by one adjudicator to give a solo competition result. At the end of the championship, there will be an overall championship result as well as results of individual solo rounds.

## NOTE: Under 9 Prelim and Open Championship competitors MUST do a traditional set for their set round.

Open to dancers who have placed 1<sup>st</sup> in three Preliminary Championships thus advancing to Open Championship 3 rounds: Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (40 bars), Treble Jig (48 bars) or Hornpipe (40 bars), Set Dance U9 MUST perform Traditional Set Dance

Open to adult category dancers of all ages

3 rounds: Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (40 bars), Treble Jig (48 bars) or Hornpipe (40 bars), Choice of Set Dance

#### ART COMPETITION (Saturday) - Competition # 900

Artwork Gone "Green." Use recycled dance materials (duct tape, rhinestones, etc.) to create Irish themed Artwork. Winner will be chosen at the end of day on Saturday.

#### **DANCE COMPETITION RULES**

- 1. All rules of the North American Feis Commission (<u>www.northamericanfeiscommission.org</u>) are included by reference.
- 2. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
- 3. Competitions will be combined or added as the Committee sees fit based on the entries.
- 4. Competitors must be in the hall and prepared to dance one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
- 5. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered & paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
- 6. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
- 7. The Malone Academy of Irish Dance or Crown Plaza San Diego will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage. By entering this Feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify & hold harmless the Hidden Valley/Finest City Feis, The Feis Committee, Feis Volunteers, Vendors, Crown Plaza San Diego, the Donna Means School of Irish Dance, the Malone Academy of Irish Dance for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.

# LEVEL DEFINITIONS AND ADVANCEMENT RULES

**First Feis** is not per dance. It is the first Feis ever for the dancer. Dancers may only enter First Feis once, regardless of how many dances they are competing, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna.

In **Beginner 1, Beginner 2 and Novice** the following advancement rules will apply:

- Competitions with 5 9 dancers: 1<sup>st</sup> place will advance to the next grade.
- Competitions with 10 or more dancers: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places will advance to the next grade.
- Dancers may not stay in level at teacher discretion, with the exception of back-to-back feiseanna.

Prizewinner: Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

#### Preliminary to Open Championship:

- Dancer must have 3 overall wins in competitions with 5 or more dancers. Advancement to Open is not at teacher discretion.
- Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna. This includes 2-round and 3-round Preliminary Championships.

Adults: Dancers who started after the age of 18, or who have been out of Youth/&over competition for 5 years.

**Advanced Adults:** Dancers age 18 or older who previously placed in the top 3 of a Preliminary Championship or competed at the Open Championship level in the youth/&over levels, regardless of when the competitor was last active.

- Advanced Adults do not need to be out of competition for 5 years before moving from the youth/&over categories to Advanced Adults.
- Dancers who have already been competing in the regular Adult categories do not need to move to Advanced Adults, regardless of their level or placements achieved when competing in youth/&over.
- An Advanced Adult dancer has opted to leave Youth/&over categories, and once the dancer begins competing in Advanced Adult, the dancer may not return to Youth/&over categories.

Beginner Figures: Open only to dancers in beginner for at least one solo dance.

**Open Figures:** Open to all grade levels.
