#### The Mattierin Spring Feis in the West is offering dancers many chances to dance on stage such as:

- DOUBLE Preliminary Championships
- DOUBLE Open Championships
- DOUBLE Beg/Adv Beg Reel Trophy competitions
- DOUBLE Nov/Prz Treble Jig Trophy competitions
- Best in the West Championship Belt Special
- Madonna Nixon Slip Jig Special and Boys Championship Cup
- Treble Reel, Slip lig & Tir Na Nog Special

There will be Perpetual Trophies awarded to all Championship and Trophy competitions. Preliminary Championships will be single year from U10 through U16. Based on minimum five competitors for each age group.

The annual Music Competitions times will be published in the final schedule.

## Championship Specials

Madonna Nixon Memorial Slip Jig Special

1st place winners in the Championship Slip Jig specials perform one step down the line.

The "Best in the West" Perpetual Belts

- Minor Belt (U13)
- Junior Belt (U16)
- Senior Belt (16&O)

First-place winners in Preliminary and Open Championships by age group qualify to dance one soft shoe and one hard shoe step. The Senior Belt winner also receives the Londyn Nachtigal Perpetual Trophy.

**Boys Championship Cup** 

All boys who dance in championships qualify to dance - one hard shoe, one soft shoe.



#### Tir Na Nog

The Tir Na Nog competition gives our youngest (U6), noncompetitive dancers a chance to hit the stage and show off their dancing skills. All entrants will receive an award at the end of the competition.

#### **Perpetual Trophies**

Reel & Treble Jig Trophy, Slip Jig Specials, All Championships

Perpetual trophies are provided for all Championships and Reel, Treble Jig, and Slip Jig Trophy competitions, including Perpetual Belts for the "Best in the West" Minor, Junior, and Senior Belt championship specials, a Perpetual Cup for the Boys Championship Special, and a Perpetual for the Madonna Nixon Memorial Slip Jig Special.

#### **Sashes**

Provided for Preliminary and Open Championships 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners.

#### **Music Competitions**

Non-Dancer entrants who are not officially part of a dance school may enter as well at the Feis on Saturday. Music competitions are open to all - dancers and non-dancers alike. Performances are limited to 2.5 min wherein competitors can play up to two Irish tunes of their choice. Ages as of January 1, 2025. You can enter (\$15/entrant) on Feisworx.com or at the feis.

#### **Art Competition**

Non-Dancer entrants who are not officially part of a dance school may enter as well at the Feis on Saturday. The Art competition is open to all - dancers and non-dancers alike. Entry is \$10/art piece. All art must be submitted by 11:00 AM at the feis on Saturday, March 29th and must be taken home after the awards. Be sure art is labelled clearly with name, age, and phone number. Art must have Irish cultural theme (legends, celtic knots, etc.) and can be created with any art medium (paint, sketch, crayon, sculpture, etc.).

#### **Soda Bread Competition**

Non-Dancer entrants who are not officially part of a dance school may enter as well at the Feis on Saturday. The soda bread competition is open to all - dancers and non-dancers alike. Entry is \$10/loaf. Entries will be judged on appearance, texture and taste. Soda Bread must be submitted by 11:00 AM at the feis on Saturday, March 29th. The winner will be announced after lunch. All entries are property of the feis once submitted.

## Feis Rules

- 1. Competitions are open to amateurs only. Only students of teachers registered in good standing with the WCIDTA, IDTANA, and An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha may compete.
- 2. Competitors ages will be determined as of January 1st, 2025.
- 3. Entry forms are to be checked and signed by the registering teacher.
- 4. Music shall be in accordance with regulation metronome speeds.
- 5. Categories:
  - First Feis A dancer who has not qualified for Adv. Beginner for that dance.
  - Beginner A dancer who has not qualified for Adv. Beginner for that dance.
  - Advanced Beginner A dancer who has received qualifying place in that particular dance in the Beginner level but has not yet qualified to move on to Novice in that particular dance.
  - Novice A dancer who has received qualifying place in that particular dance in the Advanced Beginner level but has not yet qualified to move on to Prizewinner in that particular dance.
- Prizewinner A dancer who has received qualifying place in that particular dance in the Novice level but has not yet qualified to advance to Preliminary Championships.
- First Feis Trophy (Reel 32 bars) Open to dancers entered in their first feis, Dancers may not compete in any other Trophy competition.
- Beginner / Advanced Beginner Trophies Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Beg / Adv. Beginner level in solos. A dancer must advance to Novice/Prizewinner trophy if they receive two first place trophies, or if they advance in the majority of their solo levels.
- Beginner / Advanced Beginner Trophies Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Beg / Adv. Beginner level in solos. A dancer must advance to Novice/Prizewinner trophy if they receive two first place trophies, or if they advance in the majority of their solo levels
- Novice / Prizewinner Trophies (Treble Jig OR Hornpipe 32 bars, choice of two speeds) Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Novice or Prizewinner level in their solos. Also open to dancers who have previously won two first place trophies in the Beg/Adv Beginner Trophy competitions. Dancers in ALL age groups dance the Treble Jig.
- Preliminary Championships Open to dancers who have won two first place trophies in the Novice/ Prizewinner Trophy competition, and who have not previously won two first place Preliminary Championships.



- Open Championships Open to dancers who have previously won three first place Preliminary Championships, or two Prelim Championships prior to August 31, 2024.
- Adult Championships Open to dancers aged 18 and over, who have not competed in nonadult competitions (also known as youth/&over categories) for solo or team events during the previous five (5) years.
- Advanced Adult Championship: Open to dancers aged 18 and over, who have previously placed
  in the top 3 of a Preliminary Championship or competed in Open Championship levels in the
  youth/&over levels, regardless of when the competitor was active. An Advanced Adult dancer has
  opted to leave the youth/&over categories, and once the dancer begins competing in Advanced
  Adult the dancer may not return to the youth/&over categories.

NOTE: Teachers with Adult dancers are strongly advised to consult the IDTANA Handbook for all rules related to adult dancing and competitions.

- 6. Competitors may only dance each dance once. Competitors entered in First Feis may repeat the Reel & Light Jig at the Beginner Level.
- 7. In Figure dancing, 50% of a team may be moved to a higher age group to complete a figure unless the Feis Committee has granted special permission. All Ceili dances must be performed in accordance with the Official book "An Rince Foirne"
- 8. A competition may be cancelled or combined with a higher age group if there are less than 3 entries. If the entry is 40 or higher, the competition will be split.
- 9. Dancers should be in the hall 60 minutes before scheduled time of their competition.
- 10. All dancers must be in costume, complete with shoes and number to receive any award onstage.
- 11. Under no circumstances are the adjudicators or the musicians to be approached during the feis. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. No steel taps or bubble heels allowed. Shoes may be subject to inspection by adjudicators. Costumes must be in accordance with the IDTANA and An Coimisiun guidelines.
- 13. The Emerald Isle Dancers Association, Mattierin Spring Feis in the West, Mattierin School of Irish Dance, W.C.I.D.T.A., the venue, or any organization affiliated with same will not be held responsible for personal injury, property loss or damage during an event.
- 14. Protest against a breach of rules will be considered if made in writing and signed by the objector. The objection must also, be accompanied with a \$25.00 fee and reach the feis committee before prizes are presented. If the complaint is justified, the \$25.00 fee will be refunded.
- 15. Competitors may only compete in a Trophy competition OR a Championship, but not both. Specials (Treble Reel, Slip Jig) do not apply in this case.
- 16. Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst

- 17. Notwithstanding any other conditions specified herein, the Feis Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to alter or cancel any rule or condition as it may be deemed necessary in the best interest of the Feis. All teachers will be advised. The Feis reserves the right to reject any entry for cause, to cancel all or part of the Feis and to limit competitor's performing time. The decision of the Feis Committee is final in all matters connected with the Feis.
- 18. Dancers shall advance in each individual solo dances as follows:

<5 Dancers</li>
5 - 9 dancers
10 - 19 dancers
20 - 29 dancers
30 or more dancers
No placing advances
1st place moves up
1st, 2nd & 3rd move up
1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th move up
1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th move up

- 19. Dancers shall advance in Trophy competitions and Championship as follows:
  - A dancer who wins two first place trophies in the Beginner/Advanced Beginner Trophy advances to the Novice/Prizewinner Trophy, or:
  - A dancer who advances to Novice or Prizewinner for the majority of their solo levels (hard shoes in particular) +automatically advances to the Novice/prizewinner Trophy.
  - A dancer who wins two first places Novice/Prizewinner Trophy competitions advances to Preliminary Championships.
  - A dancer who wins three first place Preliminary Championship competitions advances to Open Championships
  - Should a dancer win a third Preliminary Championship on the first day of competition, they are eligible to move to Open Championship on the second day of competition. If they choose to withdraw from a pre-registered second Preliminary Championship, they are not eligible for a refund from that competition, but may transfer that registration fee to the Open Championship competition.
- 21. All feis committees must award a minimum of 30% of competitors in Preliminary and Open Championships.
- 22. Shiny plastic number cards should not be used.
- 23. By entering the Mattierin Spring Feis in the West, dancers, teachers, and all spectators agree to be respectful and polite to all volunteers, competitors and their families. Disrespectful and abusive behaviour will absolutely not be tolerated. The Feis committee reserves the right to remove anyone from the event at their discretion.
- 24. All other Feis rules as per the An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha, the I.D.T.A.N.A. and the W.C.I.D.T.A.

- Beg/Adv-Beginner Trophy: Majority of a dancer' solo competitions (at least 4) must be must in the Beginner or Advanced Beginner Solo Category - 32 bars (two steps) Reel
- Novice/Prizewinner Trophy: 32 bars (two steps) Treble Jig OR Hornpipe with choice of speed
- o Slip Jig Special: Dancers must dance in the same category as their Solo Slip Jig
- o Treble Reels: 16 bars (one step down the line) Dancers must dance in the same category as their highest Hardshoe Solo
