## Reasoning for Saturday Black Out

As the name of the Feis implies we all need to do our part to "Save the Planet." While our Feis is not going to alter the course of global warming or dramatically reduce the amount of waste entering our landfills and oceans, we as a group can take small steps to lessen our impact locally. In an effort to do our part, we have decided to make the feis a reduce waste challenge. We are asking all participants to compete in Black Out costume on Saturday. No wigs/hair pieces, taping of shoes or tanner. Why no wigs/hair pieces or tanner? The chemicals used in the manufacture of these products are known pollutants and the vast majority of the wigs/hair pieces are synthetic fibers which can't be recycled. Also, wigs/hair pieces require chemical hairspray to keep wispsies under control for pouffs and color sprays for color matching all generate aerosol pollutants. No taping because of the yards of plastic tape that are used at each feis is appalling. We have all seen the tape balls littering the floors of venues or tossed balls of it removed from dance shoes at home. We are also asking all attendees to refrain from single use water bottles.

## LEVEL ADVANCEMENT AND DEFINITION

**First Feis:** It is not per dance; it is the first Feis ever for the dancer. Only one first feis regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in case of back-to-back feiseanna.

**In B1, B2 and Novice the following will apply:** 5 - 9 dancers 1st place will advance to the next grade 10 or more dancers 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion

**Prizewinner:** Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

**Preliminary to Open Championship:** Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round Preliminary Championships.

**Adults:** Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have been out of competitions for 5 years
